The LEC.COM Web Browser service requires connection to the internet. With this service, subscribers always have access to the latest translation engines. For users with limited computing resources, the LEC.COM Web Browser service offloads the translation to powerful LEC servers. Subscribers simply point their web browser to the LEC.COM Web Browser home page at www.lec.com/WebBrowserService to get started. After signing in to the service, subscribers choose a Web, Text, File, or Email icon depending upon their translation requirements.

Subscriptions for Translate DotNet in 2004 increased 50% over those for 2003, signifying growing acceptance of the subscription model for software services. In anticipation of the expanded demand for its services, in 2004 LEC upgraded all of its translation servers to 3.4 GHz Xeon processors and signed a multi-year agreement to collocate its Translate DotNet infrastructure at Safecore's state-of-the-art data center in Medford, Massachusetts.
